## **ORGANISATION**

Airbus SE ("Airbus") is a global leader in aeronautics, space and related services. In 2017 it generated revenues of €67 billion and employed a workforce of around 129,000. Airbus offers the most comprehensive range of passenger airliners from 100 to more than 600 seats and business aviation products. Airbus Financial Services Ltd ("AFS"), based in Dublin's IFSC is a subsidiary of Airbus SAS, which provides aircraft financing for a number of Airbus customers, leasing directly or through financing vehicles to airlines. It actively manages the Airbus customer financing exposure and hedges its interest and foreign currency risk.

Airbus Flight Hour Services Ltd ("AFHS"; a wholly (100%) owned subsidiary of AFS), enters into flight hour service contracts with customers of Airbus to manage aircraft component spares and rotables availability and repairs on behalf of the customer. It currently manages approximately 18,500 parts in numerous locations worldwide.

## **DIMENSIONS**

### **VAT Compliance for AFHS (or the 'Company')**

- Manage, control and satisfy the Company's global VAT compliance reporting requirements with a material focus on the EU compliance requirements,
- Assist in gathering accurate information on the movement of aircraft spare parts in order to prepare and file VAT, Intrastat and EU Sales Listing returns in the jurisdictions filings as required,
- Working with the global Airbus teams, particularly the VAT, Customs and Inventory (for aircraft spare parts) teams to satisfy the above, while gaining a strong understanding and knowledge of the internal systems with a view to enhancing same,
- Working with local VAT Corporate Service Providers ("CSP") to satisfy compliance requirements, where the Company already has a VAT registration and establishing new CSP relationships for new jurisdictions where the Company will be required to VAT register due to continued develop of the Company's trading activity.

### **Commercial Support**

- Assist in the review and drafting of tax provisions in transaction documents to reflect the commercial intent and tax risk allocation.
- Be mindful of changes in tax law domestically, throughout the EU and in jurisdictions the companies operate in worldwide and provide early warning alerts to management of tax changes that have a commercial impact on the businesses.

### **Financial Reporting**

- Assist in accounting for taxes in the Company's monthly financial statements and legal entity statutory accounts including VAT and corporation tax calculations, maintaining deferred tax asset/ liability schedules and preparing valuation allowance assessments, etc.
- Liaising with external auditors on accounting for taxes issues.
- Provide support to finance team to facilitate the monthly reporting process.

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## **Systems Development:**

- Evaluating and developing existing systems and processes to ensure accurate, timely and value added reporting on the financial results of the Company,
- Implementing new systems and processes as the Company maintains its excellent IT benchmark.
