New Tax Stamp on Tobacco Products

The Revenue Commissioners are introducing a new Tobacco Tax Stamp for cigarettes and fine cut tobacco used in “roll your own” products. The new stamp will start appearing on packets in April 2015.

The new Tobacco Tax Stamp contains enhanced security features to guard against counterfeiting and fraud.

The new stamp and the old stamp will both feature on tobacco products for a short period. The old stamp will be phased out as stocks are sold or depleted.
